About School

A Tradition of Excellence

With more than 750 years of educational heritage, Abingdon School combines a long tradition with a modern approach to learning. Located in the heart of Abingdon, Oxfordshire, the School occupies approximately 35 acres of attractive grounds and is around 6 miles from Oxford. Its location also provides convenient access to London and major international travel connections, with Heathrow Airport approximately 1 hour away by car.

Abingdon is widely recognised for its strong academic performance. Its examination results regularly place the school among leading UK independent schools, with many pupils progressing to prestigious universities, including Russell Group institutions, Oxford, Cambridge and leading London universities.

Boarding is available from age 13 (year 9), with both full and weekly boarding options. The three boarding houses bring together boarders and day students, creating an integrated school community. Each house is supported by a Head of House, tutors and dedicated staff, while recent renovations have added improved communal areas, study spaces and accommodation.

Now Welcoming Girls – 2026

A major development for Abingdon in 2026 is its transition to co-education. From September 2026, girls are joining Year 7 (First Year) and Year 12 (Lower Sixth), marking the first stage of the School's move towards becoming fully co-educational. Girls will join Year 9 (Third Year) from September 2028, with the School planned to become fully co-educational from September 2030.

Modern Facilities

Abingdon offers extensive facilities across its main campus and additional sports sites. These include a 21-laboratory Science Centre, 450-seat theatre, dedicated Sixth Form Centre, Arts Centre, Sports Centre, 8-lane 25m swimming pool, boathouse and specialist facilities for Computer Science, Economics and Business Studies. The School continues to invest in its learning and boarding environments.

11+ & 13+ Entry

Admission to Abingdon School is academically selective and involves entrance assessments, an interview and a reference from the candidate's current school. The assessments cover English, Mathematics and Reasoning, with a combination of computer-based and handwritten papers. International students may also take the assessments at authorised centres. 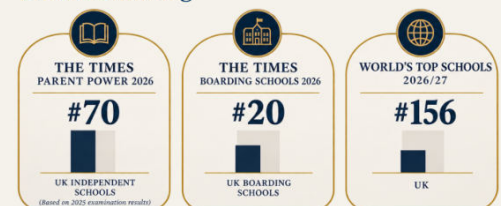
