Caterham School welcomes applications from pupils aged 3–18. Entry is by assessment and interview, with different processes for each age group. For Years 7 and 9 (11+ and 13+), applicants take entrance assessments in English, Mathematics and, for some, a subject assessment, followed by an interview. Sixth Form entry is based on academic performance, interviews and references. Scholarships and bursaries are available, and the school also supports international students.
