About School

Lancing College, founded in 1868, is a leading independent school for boys and girls aged 13–18, set in 200 acres of beautiful grounds on the South Downs, with stunning views of the English Channel. The school is known for its academic excellence, strong pastoral care and a broad curriculum, offering both traditional values and modern opportunities.

Lancing is near Brighton and Hove, with easy access to London, making it well connected for travel. The school is approximately 1.5 hours by car from London Gatwick Airport. Alternatively, it is around 2 hours by train from Gatwick to Brighton, followed by a short taxi journey (about 15 minutes) to the school.

The school offers a wide range of co-curricular activities, including sport, music, art, drama and outdoor education, helping students develop confidence, resilience and a global outlook.

Admission is selective, with entry at 11+ and 13+ (Year 7 and Year 9), and Sixth Form entry at 16+. The school looks for academic potential, character and a good fit with its values. Scholarships and bursaries are available, and the admissions team can advise on specific questions.
